Conditions of Entry.

- All nominations with accompanying fees must be received by 18th September 2005. The signing of the entry form by the competitor and the club secretary is a declaration attesting to the correctness of the information contained in the entry form.
- 2005 NRA Action Pistol rules, with official amendments thereof will apply to all matches.
- Chronograph ammunition will be collected at all events and tested over a chronograph for power factor.
- Competitors will be expected to act as target changers and observers for the next detail of competitors.
- All resident Australian competitors must be financial members of Sporting Shooters Association of Australia and / or Pistol Australia Inc. and carry a current membership card.
- Holster certificates will be required.

Club Rules.

- Alcohol may be consumed in the clubroom of the BPC after you have completed your shooting for the day.
- Guns not to be worn off the range area including the car park.
- Full metal-jacketed (hard ball) projectiles will not be used in any event in these matches, semi-jacketed and jacketed hollow point projectiles may be used.
- Smoking is not permitted in the clubroom.
- All visitors to the BPC MUST sign the visitors' books when entering. Children must be under the supervision of an adult whilst at the pistol range.
